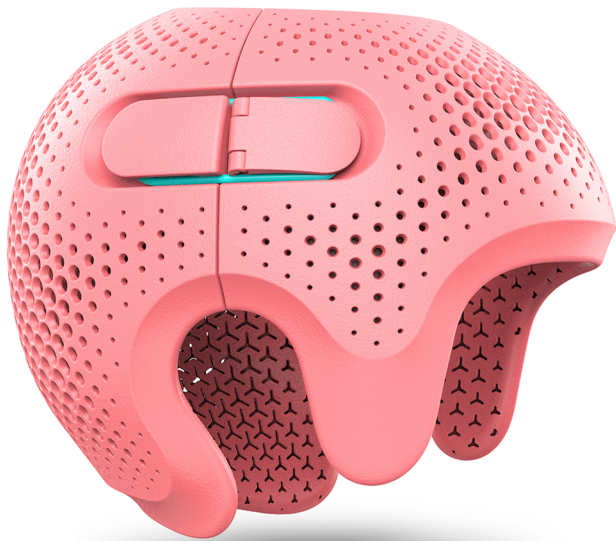

# Plagiocephaly

Head shape deformity became more frequent after the Back to Sleep Program focused on preventing SIDS<sup>1</sup>. Nowadays, more than 3% of newborn babies<sup>2</sup> have severe or very severe head shape deformity. Up to 50% have a mild or medium deformity.

Research<sup>3</sup> shows that orthotic treatment using a helmet is the most effective solution for severe head shape deformity (plagiocephaly). The orthosis gently allows the head to correct as it grows. The treatment has a high success rate and only takes about 4 to 6 months. The best time to get started is when your baby is around 4 months old.
